

The University of Nairobi has developed a policy on attachment, internship and apprenticeship. This policy covers all the University departments and recommends the University to have partnerships with the Industry players from all sectors through Memoranda of Understanding.

The policy provides the legal framework to guide the process for a student to get an industrial attachment. This policy comes as a great relief to the students who are graduating in thousands from the University of Nairobi. With the increasing competitive labour market, it has become necessary to produce graduates who have practical experience acquired during the course of training in the university.

Strengthening the Placement office that facilitates attachment, internship and apprenticeship, sensitizing all staff members, giving recommendation letters to students, identifying supervisors for students during attachment are among the measures that the University of Nairobi will take to ensure that this policy is implemented.
